### One Day experiential-cum collection tour to Jawhar Lal Nehru Memorial Botanical Garden, Chashma Shahi, Srinagar on 25-02-2025


Herbal Gardens play a crucial role in conserving essential herbs, thus serving as repository for germplasm while also facilitating educational and research initiatives, as well as promoting health and medical tourism. Acknowledging the significance of herbal gardens and herbal/medicinal plants, the Department of Botany, Government Degree College Tral, Pulwama, organized a one-day experientialcum collection tour to Jawhar Lal Nehru Memorial Botanical Garden, Chashma Shahi, Srinagar for the students of 6<sup>th</sup> semester (NEP Batch- 2022) on February 25, 2025, under the esteemed leadership of Principal **Prof. (Dr.) Mushtaq Ahmad Malik**. A group of 19 students (Enclosure A), accompanied by three faculty members namely Dr. Mohd. Rafiq Wani (HOD Botany), Prof. Waseem Shahri, and Dr. Saduf Nissar visited the garden. The objective of this tour was to gather medicinal and aromatic plants for transplantation into the newly established Herbal Garden at Government Degree College, Tral. This initiative supports the college's mission to enhance environmental awareness, conserve medicinal plants, and provide practical learning experiences to the students. Further, the tour was instrumental in enhancing students' knowledge regarding a range of medicinal/aromatic plants, encompassing their applications, origins, botanical classifications, cultivation techniques, and chemical components.

#### Activities undertaken during the tour:

- 1. Identification and selection of medicinal and aromatic plant species under the guidance of garden experts.
- 2. Documentation of plant properties and their significance in traditional and modern medicine.
- 3. Careful collection and preparation of plants for transportation to the College Herbal Garden.


