

Report on Faculty Development Programme on Leadership Skills

A three-day Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on Leadership Skills was successfully conducted at Government Degree College, Tral, from 21st July to 23rd July 2025. The programme Was organized by the ICT Academy Tamil Nadu and co-organized by Government Degree College Tral, with the active participation of around 20 faculty members from the host institution and 15 Assistant and Associate Professors from various colleges across the Kashmir Valley.
