Institutional Best Practices

1) **Title of the Practice:** Regular cleanliness drives in and around the famous springs of Tral and its suburbs like Dilnag, Batnag etc.

Objectives of the practice: The main objective of the initiative was to decontaminate these springs to restore the virginity and pristine conditions of them.

Context: Due to global warming and climate control, most of the springs have dried up. This problem was aggravated due to encroachment and overexploitation of the water bodies. Thus, it was imperative to do regular cleanliness drives for their preservation.

The Practice: Based on the decisions that were taken in the meeting convened by IQAC of the college with the NSS and Debates and Seminar committee of the college on 18-11-2022, a cleanliness cum drive was carried out on 02-12-2022 at adopted water body "Dilnag" with the active participation of NSS units I and II and Eco-Club of the college.

Evidence of the Success: The programme was a success as the outlets from the spring were fully cleaned in addition to the cleaning of the paths and the lawns of Dilnag.

2) Title of the Practice: Extend Educational awareness to school going boys and girls in the two adopted kandy villages of Tral "Brenpathri and Nagbal" and awareness about government schemes launched for the upliftment of poor sections of the society and also to provide assistance to people in these villages struck by calamities.

Objectives of the practice: The main objective of the initiative is to benefit these disadvantaged and economically weaker sections of the society.


Context: Since these village fall under backward zone and most of the people belong to disadvantaged and economically weaker sections of the society (Sc, ST, RBA etc). The college decides to adopt these villages for their overall socio-economic growth and development.

The Practice: A survey expedition was carried out on 21-12-2023 in two adopted villages "Brenpathri and Nagbal" by the NSS units of the college and members of the Debates and Seminar committee. Numerous issues related with the educational and other socioeconomic domains were discussed with the locals of the village.

Evidence of the Success: On 22 January 2024, GDT Tral had raised a fund-raising event soon after a fire incident in the adopted village "Brenpathri" and helped the fire victimized family who had lost everything including their residential house and cowshed and provided them tent, blankets, food grains and other essential commodities.

Problems encountered and Resources Required:

Financial assistance required by the victim was not completely met out though the faculty of the college volunteered themselves and contributed to the call.
